STAX

OH&S CONSULTATION

This course is designed for participants who are members of an OH&S committee or elected as an OH&S representative manager. It is the employers' responsibility to ensure that each person who is a member of an OH&S committee, or elected as an OH&S representative is provided this training.

WORK SAFELY IN THE CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY (WHITE CARD) (CPCCOHS1001A)

This course is developed for participants who require OH&S induction training prior to undertaking designated work tasks within any of the sectors within the construction industry.

MANUAL HANDLING

Our manual handling training provides participants with the skills to safely undertake manual handling tasks and reduce the risk of injury. This training program has theoretical and practical components so that participants gain a full understanding of the subject matter and are able to apply what they have learned in the workplace.

WORK SAFELY AT HEIGHTS (RIIOHS204A)

This nationally accredited one day course is designed for persons who are required to work at heights. Participants develop skills to select height safety equipment and apply it to specific task. Training covers how to work in accordance with Height Safety Regulations and Australian Standards.

ENTER CONFINED SPACE (MSAPMPER205B)

Our nationally accredited one day course (without breathing apparatus) and two day course (with breathing apparatus) is designed to teach participants to identify confined space hazards and to work safely within confined spaces. Participants will learn to complete hazard identification, risk assessments and entry permits to Confined Space Operations.

FIRST AID – HLTF301B (INCORPORATING HLTCPR201A & HLTF201A)

This course is nationally accredited and will be accepted throughout all industries in Australia and is conducted over one day.

This course develops the skills and knowledge in First Aid and CPR which can be applied in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings. HLTF301B is in partial completion of the Nationally Accredited Course HLT21107, Certificate II in Emergency Medical Service First Aid Response.

CARDIO PULMONARY RESUSCITATION (CPR) – HLTCPR201A

This course is nationally accredited and will be accepted throughout all industries in Australia and is conducted over a two hour period. This course provides a basis for the further training in First Aid and complies with the requirements for CPR awareness within the Electrical Industry.
