RESPOND TO WORKPLACE EMERGENCIES

This four hour Fire / Building Warden program will equip your personnel with the skills required to safely prepare for emergency situations, reporting of emergencies, respond to emergency warnings and the safe evacuation from the workplace. This course incorporates Confine Small Workplace Emergencies Training as shown below.

CONFINE SMALL WORKPLACE EMERGENCIES

This two hour course will ensure all participants are suitably trained in the preparation, identification, assessment and confinement of an emergency. This training course includes both theory and practical components including the use of Fire Extinguishers, Fire Hose Reels and Fire Blankets to ensure that participants can safely handle workplace emergencies.

MANUAL HANDLING

Our manual handling training provides participants with the skills to safely undertake manual handling tasks and reduce the risk of injury. This training program has theoretical and practical components so that participants gain a full

WORK SAFELY AT HEIGHTS (RIIOHS204A)

This nationally accredited one day course is designed for persons who are required to work at heights. Participants develop skills to select height safety equipment and apply it to specific task. Training covers how to work in accordance with Height Safety Regulations and Australian Standards.

ENTER CONFINED SPACE (MSAPMPER205B)

Our nationally accredited one day course is designed to teach participants to identify confined space hazards and to work safely within confined spaces. Participants will learn to complete hazard identification, risk assessments and entry permits to Confined Space Operations.

APPLY FIRST AID – HLTF301B

This course is nationally accredited and will be accepted throughout all industries in Australia and is conducted over one day. This course develops the skills and knowledge in First aid and CPR which can be applied in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings. HLTF301B is in partial completion of the

Nationally Accredited Course HLT21107, Certificate II in Emergency Medical Service First Aid Response.

CARDIO PULMONARY RESUSCITATION (CPR) – HLTCPR201A

This course is nationally accredited and will be accepted throughout all industries in Australia and is conducted over a two hour period. This course provides a basis for the further training in First Aid and complies with the requirements for CPR awareness within the Electrical Industry.
